- Regulation of advice on insurance is covered by the Financial Services Authority.

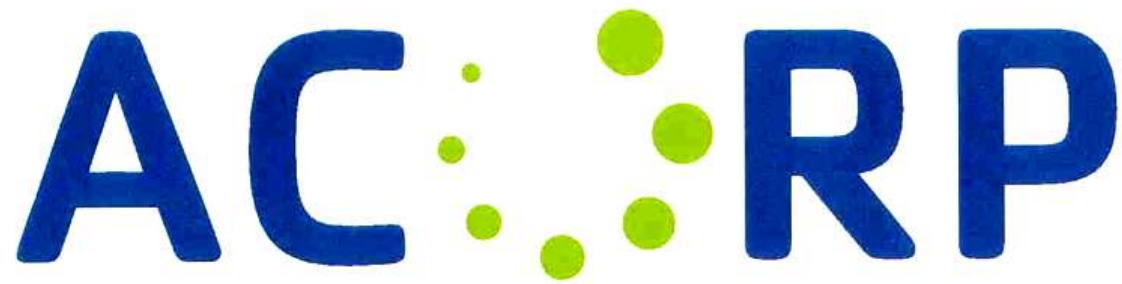
Some Questions
