For the feedback groups the following question was asked

Q. What are your priorities for your TOC & ACoRP to assist you?

The following list in priority was the result of these discussions.

TOC

- ◆ Simplify processes wherever possible
- ◆ Funding assistance/support
- ◆ Better focus on communication with Station Adoption groups & Users
- ◆ Give Station Managers more power to make decisions
- ◆ Continue bringing people together more often
- ◆ Rewards for Adopters – travel passes
- ◆ More personal contact with adopters
- ◆ Fault rectification – *Inconsistency at the moment*

ACoRP

- ◆ Funding Advice – How to write a good funding bid
- ◆ Communication – Train Times & Train on Line (future of Train Times)
- ◆ Annual Train Times featuring the work of Stations Adoption Groups – Event handing out hard copies at large stations.
- ◆ All delegates agreed that hard copy Train Times is an excellent promotional tool!
- ◆ Station Adoption & Community Rail promotion – at a high level

Ideas for showcasing/promoting Station Adoption groups and Community Rail Partnerships

- ◆ Empty shop premises etc on stations could be used to display/showcase the work of groups
- ◆ Double Royal generic posters at stations promoting CR & Station Adoption
- ◆ Events at Main Line stations – promoting ‘Get out of the City/Town’ and use CR Lines to access countryside, coast, tourist attractions. Leeds, Manchester etc.
